**BERKELEY REP RENTS ITS THEATRES & FACILITIES TO LOCAL GROUPS****Local arts agencies and nonprofits to benefit**

JULY 15, 2011 – Today Berkeley Repertory Theatre announced that, during its 2011-12 Season, it will make up to **320 hours available for public rental** of its facilities. Rentals are a key way that Berkeley Rep engages with the community and, as part of that service, priority is given to Berkeley-based arts organizations and other not-for-profit agencies that benefit the local community. These rental hours are provided as part of the agreement governing the Theatre's relationship with the City of Berkeley.

During the theatre season that begins September 1, 2011 and runs through August 31, 2012, the following spaces will be available for rental on the specified dates:

- **THRUST STAGE** (2025 Addison Street)  
Capacity: 401  
Availability : October 31, 2011; November 14, 2011; and April 9, 2012
- **RODA THEATRE** (2015 Addison Street)  
Capacity: 587  
Availability: October 24, 2011 and February 27, 2012
- **SCHOOL OF THEATRE: THE BAKERY** (2071 Addison Street)  
Room Dimensions: 39' x 30'  
Availability: September 12-13, October 17-18, and November 7-8, 2011 and January 30-31, February 27-28, March 5-6, April 2-3, April 9-10, May 7-8, and May 14-15, 2012
- **SCHOOL OF THEATRE: LOFT** (2071 Addison Street)  
Room Dimensions: 34' x 18'  
Availability: September 26-27, October 17-18, and November 14-15, 2011 and January 30-31, February 6-7, March 5-6, March 26-27, April 2-3, April 9-10, May 7-8, and May 14-15, 2012
- **SCHOOL OF THEATRE: BLUE ROOM** (2071 Addison Street)  
Room Dimensions: 34' x 15'  
Availability: September 12-13, October 17-18, October 31, and November 1, 2011 and January 30-31, February 6-7, March 5-6, March 26-27, April 2-3, April 9-10, May 7-8, and May 14-15, 2012

**Berkeley-based organizations and businesses will get first priority** in the following order: not-for-profit arts organizations, for-profit arts organizations, other not-for-profit organizations, educational or governmental entities, and non-arts-related, for-profit businesses. These dates will be held exclusively for public rentals until September 15, 2011; other dates for rental of these spaces may become available during the season.
